#### Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand Mark 6: 30-44

<sup>30</sup> The apostles gathered around Jesus and reported to him all they had done and taught. <sup>31</sup> Then, because so many people were coming and going that they did not even have a chance to eat, he said to them, "Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest."

<sup>32</sup> So they went away by themselves in a boat to a solitary place. <sup>33</sup> But many who saw them leaving recognized them and ran on foot from all the towns and got there ahead of them. <sup>34</sup> When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things.<sup>35</sup> By this time it was late in the day, so his disciples came to him. "This is a remote place," they said, "and it's already very late. <sup>36</sup> Send the people away so that they can go to the surrounding countryside and villages and buy themselves something to eat."

<sup>37</sup> But he answered, "You give them something to eat." They said to him, "That would take more than half a year's wages<sup>[a]</sup>! Are we to go and spend that much on bread and give it to them to eat?"

<sup>38</sup> "How many loaves do you have?" he asked. "Go and see. "When they found out, they said, "Five—and two fish."

<sup>39</sup> Then Jesus directed them to have all the people sit down in groups on the green grass. <sup>40</sup> So they sat down in groups of hundreds and fifties. <sup>41</sup> Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves. Then he gave them to his disciples to distribute to the people. He also divided the two fish among them all. <sup>42</sup> They all ate and were satisfied, <sup>43</sup> and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces of bread and fish. <sup>44</sup> The number of the men who had eaten was five thousand.

#### From the Pastor's Desk

Do not remember the former things or consider the things of old. I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth; do you not perceive it? —Isaiah 43:18-19a

So many exciting things are happening right now in the church. As Spring brings new life all around us and we head into a Summer full of brighter days, beautiful weather, and vacation adventures, we are seeing much life spring up in the church as well. I encourage everyone to take their vacations and have a blast during them. I also encourage and invite you to come and partake in the many things which will be happening here at Roberts Congregational UCC this Summer and into Fall!

We kicked things off a few weeks ago with the start of our year long stewardship program, "From Bread and Cup to Faith and Giving." *People from the East and West and North and South Eat Bread in the Realm of God (Luke13:22-30)* Activity: Serving at a local shelter dinner or food distribution center.

There will be many more celebrations and activities as well (including a trip to a vineyard/winery – watch for details on them in upcoming newsletters and emails). Come and join the Christian Ed team in discussing the Scripture of that Sunday and partaking in the activities. Activities may be scheduled for another date, but we will try to keep people informed in advance.

While the Deacons work on planning worship activities, communications and our final Celebration activity, and the Christian Ed Team work on the discussion groups and activities, The Trustees will be working on a Narrative Budget to show us just how the finances and time we give to the church helps us to meet our mission. And this is just for our Stewardship.

We also have our outdoor Ecumenical Good Neighbor Days Worship with Cross Lutheran Church happening on June 4<sup>th</sup>, 9am, at the Roberts Park. A good time to come and share in

fellowship, Communion, and worship with our brothers and sisters in the area. Our VBS Program, "On the Case." is ramping up to kick off (June 25-28) and we are already getting registrations (including some from outside the congregations thanks to the SCC School system allowing us to send out information through them). Here is the best part. VBS is no longer just for the kids. We have a multitude of adult and teen volunteers and family members attending as well. We encourage all our members to come and share in our church "family" time with the kids!

Meeting was called to order Lori at 6:00 P.M.

Opening devotion was led by Toni: "The Bible or Star Wars"

Minutes: April 4 minutes were reviewed. Motion was made by to Duane to approve the minutes and seconded by Toni. Motion carried.

#### **Old Business:**

**Christian Education:** 

- Will be serving fellowship from now on the first Sunday of the month
- Continuing to plan VBS: Tony and Lori will take care of snacks
- Fund raising ideas: 1) Coffee mug sales in October/November. Mugs will have church logo and/or be decorated by the children and 2) "Silly Supper" to be held late summer or early fall.
- Toni is willing to coordinate a church wide picnic. Asking that all council members bring this to his or her group to brainstorm ideas in which the group can assist with this picnic to be held on September 17<sup>th</sup>.
- <u>Trustees:</u> CE is requesting that the children be allowed to plant cucumbers in pots along the west wall of the church. Trellises would be next to the pots. Cucumbers would be sold as a fund raiser in which monies generated may go into the general fund. Permission is needed from the trustees to do this.

#### Deacons:

- Thanks to the pastor for the Bible Study held during Lent.
- Kicking off a year-long stewardship campaign. Campaign is called "From Bread and Cup to Faith and Giving." The first letter about this campaign will go out with the first quarter financial statements to all members and friends of the church.
- Pastor mentioned that the Deacons began discussing holding a fair for nonprofit groups in the area

- Gerten's Fundraiser has been successful. Approximately 21 orders were placed. \$600.00 profit raised.
- Made 20 Feel Good Kits. Will contact school to see if there are children that need them over the summer, or if they should be kept until next fall.
- Serving dinner at Grace Place on June 15th. Sign up genius will again be used for support of this project.
- Sending a group of volunteers to Feed My Starving Children on May 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Next meeting: June 12<sup>th</sup>.

#### Pastor:

- Upcoming baptism on May 21<sup>st</sup> of Silas Rogers, son of Dan and Beth Rogers
- Pastor updated progress of transition to One Board Governance. To date, the following have agreed to serve on this committee: Pastor Burt, Dawn Budrow, Patti Robertson, Tracy Ronnander, Jenny Korn, Duane Loewel, and Laura Logas. Connie Mueller will serve as Recording Secretary. The pastor will contact all members to establish meeting times in which all are available.
- Pastor's Scheduled 2023 Vacation: June 14-20, July 12 18, Aug. 2 8, Aug. 21 24, and Sept. 1-13. Need coverage for June 18, July 16, August 6, Sept. 3, and Sept. 10.
- Pastor is beginning a six week continuing education course.
- Has begun planning for his 2024 sabbatical.

- Lori asked if the trustees have found a chairperson for the church auction or set a date.

#### Women's Fellowship:


- Spring Rummage Sale: generated over \$1000.00.
