
From the Pastor's Desk... My sacrifice, O God, is a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart you, God, will not despise. -Psalms 51:17

Lori Jurek (Moderator, S.H.I.F.T. and Women's Fellowship), Tony Jurek (Trustees), Toni Williams (CE), Duane Loewel (Deacons), Pastor Burt Williams, and Connie Mueller

Due to the number of people unavailable in August and September, a decision was made to provide updates for both months.

Christian Education:

- Held a joint meeting with the Deacons regarding the All Church "*Fun*-Raiser" Picnic. Tents will be set up. Potluck will include hot dogs and drinks. Activities suggested were egg roll, 3-legged race, cake/baked goods walk hosted by SHIFT, pie eating contest, and "Pie the Pastor".
