From the Pastor

Sabbatical was.



SABBATICAL PLANS

you all about my upcoming Sabbatical. I began by outlining what a Sabbatical is. In ministry, it is a period of time allotted to a Pastor every so many years (in my case it is supposed to be 3 months for every five years of service) designed to give time to specifically focus on spiritual growth and renewal, study, and professional development. I wrote that it was also a time for churches to celebrate: a time to celebrate the pastor-congregation relationship; a time to celebrate our strengths and work on our growing edges as well; a time to celebrate our love and

integrity as a congregation. I also conveyed that over

the next few months I would go into greater detail

regarding what I would be doing on Sabbatical

around the three purposes I listed in what a

All three areas for me are interrelated but have very specific roles over this three-month period. As I am planning out this Sabbatical, I am starting with looking at the *Study* portion first. I have three main items I am going to be looking at for Study. The first is two of the books I have spoken about over the last year which I want to go much deeper into study over this time away.

One is the book Sacred Rest: Recover Your Life, Renew Your Energy, Restore Your Sanity by Dr. Saundra Dalton-Smith. This will cross over greatly into both the Spiritual Growth and Renewal portion as well as the Professional Development portion of my plan. I will speak more to both of those in upcoming articles. The premise of Dr Dalton-Smith's book is that there are various types of rest needed to avoid burnout and remain effective to living your best life personally and professionally. She goes into various ways of identifying what types an individual needs and possible ways to better achieve the rest that is needed.

The second book I will be studying is *The 6 Types of Working Genius: A Better Way to Understand Your Gifts, Your Frustrations, and Your Team* by Pat Lencioni. Mr. Lencioni is the founder of *The Table Group* a consulting group for businesses around Team development and management. This is one of several books I may read by him over the time I am

away, but this one is of particular interest to me for looking much deeper into. It deals with primarily how to help best structure teams to meet their greatest potential without burning out leadership. This is of particular interest to me as we move into the future and looking at the many changes our world has undergone and is going through and its effects on our leadership as a congregation. It also ties in with Dr. Dalton's book as well. Again, I will speak more to how there is crossover to the other two areas in upcoming articles.

My final point of study will be around technology. We currently have several software platforms we are using in the church office, and we are using them to only a minute fraction of their capabilities. I would like to be able to use them to a much greater extent to streamline what is happening at the church and better advance us into the future. In order to do that I need to learn a great deal more about the capabilities and procedures of these platforms (Microsoft Teams, Exchange, Outlook; our Breeze Church Management Software; Ministry Designs Website Development Software). All of these are at our disposal through things we are already paying for. All of them have online coursework which can be taken. All of them are extremely powerful tools we could be using in order to communicate better with our current members as well as reaching out into our greater community for our future development and ministry.

As I stated last month, Sabbatical is not a three-month vacation, but a serious matter and opportunity for us as pastors to be better equipped for helping our congregations to be the best that they can be. Just the study of these three areas could easily fill up a three-month period and there is more to come yet. So, as I continue planning this sabbatical, I am going to need to manage my time well and focus on those things which are most important. The other point is with the way I am planning it there is purposely a great amount of overlap in all three areas so as to make the most of this time I am being blessed with.

The point of conveying all this to you is to hopefully help you all to see the benefit of this Sabbatical time for both myself as a pastor and us as a congregation. I am extremely grateful you are



CHURCH COUNCIL UPDATES ROBERTS CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH OF CHRIST February 1, 2024

Update Reports:

Christian Education:

- For Lent, RUCCUS families will each have a container to collect loose change in. There will be an additional container at church. The monies collected will be given to Feed My Starving Children.
- The next date for volunteering for Feed My Starving Children is April 27.
- Valentine's Dinner Roulette is being planned. Tickets may be purchased in advance. Fourteen tickets have been sold so far.
- Vacation Bible School will be held on June 23-26th from 6-8 P.M. The first evening will begin with a potluck at 5:00 P.M.
- CE will cover 2 services during the pastor's sabbatical. August 4th will be led by the children. Sept. 8th will be a music Sunday.
- The Annual Church Picnic will be held on August 4th after worship.

Deacons:

- Church Board Team: Laura reviewed what the Church Board Team has been accomplishing. On Feb. 25th, all past and new board members will hold a meeting after church regarding governance proposal.
- Mission to reach out to new and existing members. Beginning next month, the board will begin generating
 ideas how this can be done. We will begin by sending out notes to people, maybe thank you and/or missing
 you notes.
- Pastor Burt presented an outline for Lent 2024. "Going Home"
- Pastor Burt discussed the increasing number of requests for financial help assistance from the area and what he is currently doing.
- Discussion was held regarding Pastor Burt's sabbatical. It was decided that communion would be served throughout that time.

Trustees:

- An annual audit was completed and all accounts were found to be in order.

- Tony, Diane, and Patti have received training to cover the treasurer position until someone else is able to take over or another solution is found.

- Quick Books program will continue to be used. By purchasing the program through Sonya, the church should be able to use this program for the next four or five years.
- Continued work on weather stripping the doors. Hopes are that this will be completed within the next month.
- The kitchen vent, the low drain, and the dishwasher check were completed. All are in good order.
- Following discussion, it was decided that an additional bank account would be necessary in order to contain monies donated specifically for those in need. The funds generated will then be available from which the pastor can not only use for such purposes but it will also have documentation as to how the monies have been distributed.

As shared at the annual meeting, a new Church Board Team made up of members from each board has been meeting to talk about creating a framework for launching our church governance into the future.




