Spiritual Growth and Rest

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

- Matthew 5:6

Our passage above talks about "...those who hunger and thirst for righteousness..." Often when we hear the word "righteousness" it has some negative connotations for us. We hear the word, but we either unconsciously add the word "Self" before it or we think of it as something impossible for us because of our personal histories and faults. Righteousness in Scripture, especially as it is used in the passage above, is not about something we attain. Instead, it is the way in which God is able to set things "right." It is about the growth of our spiritual connection with God and how, in and through us, God is able to move in the world for change and transformation. That thirst and hunger is something many of us long for. We see so much in our world today which our hearts break because of. We experience hardships, pains, illnesses, and losses. Our hearts hurt because we are unsure of what we can do to even begin to heal or change situations. They are just too much for us. This becomes even more true as we struggle to maintain our own faith and hope in our personal and spiritual lives.

Over the years many of us have worked extremely hard to make a difference in the lives of our families, communities, and congregations and it almost seems as though things are going backwards rather than forwards. We are exhausted and spiritually drained. We have put our time in. One more long-term commitment is just one thing too many. We need rest and crave (thirst and hunger for) some spiritual growth.

About a year ago a group we have named the Church Board Team was formed for this very reason, to take a look at how we are organized and running as a congregation and see if there may be a way to restructure in order to better do the ministry God is calling us to. We have some pretty amazing ministries happening here already, but is there a way in which to do them better and give more opportunity for a greater participation in those ministries while allowing for that rest and spiritual growth which is desired and needed at the same time?

This group has worked diligently for the last year to pull together a framework which our congregation could now take and develop into a plan for transformation and growth for the future. It is not THE plan, and does not hold THE answers, but instead it is a model which we as a church family could build on and alter to fit the mission and vision God is calling us to. In some ways it is very different from how we are organized now. Yet, in many ways it is simply a set of small transformations to help us adapt to the realities of the world we live in now in order to become more streamlined and better stewards of the gifts and resources God has given us to do ministry today.

Here are some questions for you to ponder. Are there ministries you would like to be a part of, but time and commitment are an issue? Would you like to be more involved with the ministries of the congregation, but do not feel comfortable saying you will sit on a board for 3 years because things in your world have been changing so fast that you may not be able to fulfill the commitment? Have you put in a lot of time over the years and feel the need for some rest and yet miss the great feeling of being a part and helping? Have you spent so much time doing "things" in the church you just do not have time to spend on your own spiritual growth and practices and have a real longing for that? These are all real issues facing not only our congregation, but the greater church as well. These are the reasons these individuals on the Church Board Team have stepped up to do all of this research and lay out this framework. Now it is time for all of us to look at what they have to propose and come together as a congregation to see the possibilities for the future.

There will be a series of meetings: April 7 after service, April 11 at 7pm, April 13 at 10am, and April 14 after service, where they are hoping to present to you this framework so we can look at how we may move ahead for the future. This information packet is the precursor to that. Once this information is out and these meetings have happened, the team would like to get the congregation together to discuss and vote on the possibility of moving ahead to develop a detail model and plan of transition of what would work best for us as a church family for the future. Again, what is being presented is just a rough framework. There are many tweaks and possibilities which will need to be thought through to make it work specifically for us as a church family. That will be the next step. It doesn't pay to do that without the backing and support of our family though. Please plan to attend one of the meetings listed above, get informed as to what the possibilities are. Come and see where you may fit in and give your feedback so this can be something well-tailored to us and the mission and vision God has given us as a congregation. Maybe you are one of those in need of rest right now. We appreciate that more than most of you could know. Still, please come and join us. Please come learn about what is being discussed and how you may become involved in the future. The goal is to maintain the ministries we are already doing, while creating as much opportunity for growth and ministry to the community as possible in the future.

Let's come and work together as a church family to grow into God's calling for us into the future! Peace!
