- 2 Corinthians 9:7

We are coming up on that time of year for Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Stewardship Drives. We have just held our Stewardship Sunday celebration, and I talked at length about the spiritual practice of Stewardship. There are other reasons for giving though. Sometimes it is an act of gratitude. Sometimes it is a way of showing just how much someone else means to us. Sometimes it is just because it makes us feel good.

Giving is better than receiving in my book. Although I am not opposed to a gift from the heart, we live in a world that has created more holidays and giving opportunities than most of us have time or resources for. We are forced to become better stewards of the gifts God has given us or run the risk of being very unhappy servants of the world. In the very same breath being a cheerful giver is not about doing only what we want to, but what we feel we are called to...where we feel most passionately God is giving us the gifts and resources to use. Then once we have made that commitment (decision), we need to do so with a happy heart. By doing so, we begin to feel a sense of accomplishment and worth.

Too often we get caught up in giving because we are told we must, and we spend inordinate resources on things which leave us feeling unfulfilled and stretched beyond our means. This in turn adds more stress to our daily lives than is truly necessary. We become so overwhelmed that even those things which fulfill us and bring meaning to our lives become burdens.

Our God has given us so much...family, jobs, homes, faith, friends, food, time...yet the question remains, "Are we being good stewards of these gifts?"

One way of answering that question is to measure what we are doing by how fulfilled we are. For instance, a high paying job that leaves us with no time for home and family may leave us feeling very lonely and depressed. Or, buying a dozen roses to show our love, when an evening at home making dinner and spending quality time with one another may have done so much more, can leave us in a bind financially when the next emergency comes up.

Giving in ways which fulfill us is very important and is truly what God is looking for. What are you passionate about? What gifts has God given you which when you use them leave you feeling fulfilled. Make a conscience effort to place more value and time on those types of giving in the seasons to come. Of course, there are those things which we must do and do not leave us with the same level of fulfillment, and these are important as well. Just make sure that these things are not your only focus and you make time to spend time with God in doing the things you have been gifted with and help you to feel a sense of fulfillment. It is a wonderful way of spending time with God!

Take some time today to look at what God has given you. Ask where you truly feel God is calling you and where you feel most fulfilled. Then make the conscious decision to give with joy and peace to those things!

### **DONATION OPTIONS**


Our church offers **Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)** to make your gift giving easier.

No meeting was held. Updates were submitted to Connie for distribution.

### Women's Fellowship:

- Meeting will be held on October 3
- The Fall Rummage Sale was very successful. We brought in \$1,687.00. Our thanks to all the volunteers, donors, and shoppers who made this event possible.
- There will be a review and updating of monthly community dinner committees. Please let WF know if you would like to be added or removed from a committee.
- The kitchen has been inspected. No violations were found. Inspector offered some good reminders and suggestions that Judy shared with the group.
- They have been asked to host a special dinner for the Roberts Sesquicentennial Celebration in 2025. A discussion will be held with follow-up reported to Council at the next meeting.

### **Deacons:**

- Stewardship Sunday: October 20<sup>th</sup>. Letters have been mailed.
- Advent: Begins on December 1<sup>st</sup>. Church decorating will take place on November 24<sup>th</sup> following worship service. All are welcome to stay and participate. Megan will be in charge of the poinsettia order for this year. Christmas Eve services will be held at 4:30 and 11:00 P.M. More details discussing the theme for Advent will be developed and discussed at the November meeting.
- Reaching out to visitors and existing members: New pew cards were available last Sunday. It was decided that something should be put in the bulletin weekly to explain to all what they are and the purpose.

### **Trustees:**

- Financial team will be restructuring the filing system (with the help of Kelly Hueman) as it's needed.
- Check in with Katy was done by Tony. Both agree the church's relationship with Plates by Kate is going well. A few items were addressed including cleaning up the storage closet and making sure the doors are securely shut. Also addressed the potential purchase of an additional refrigerator which Katy is willing to contribute toward.
- Request for a motion sensor light switch in the kitchen pantry would be excellent for making sure that light is turned off. Tony will purchase and install such device.
- Roger Ray is looking into replacing our expensive to run 3 outdoor security wall packs with LED. He has a line on those replacement parts but is concerned about the height of the light over the fellowship hall door. Tony has a ladder that will work and volunteered to install that light after Roger purchases them.
- The old piano in the Fellowship Hall is unusable and cannot be fixed. Roger, Don, and Dylan are going to break it down, recycle the metal parts, and burn the rest of the piano at Roger's house.
- Seal-coating approved, scheduled, and now completed. Many thanks to all who spent time pulling the weeds out of the cracks in order to prevent weeds in the future.
- The roadside sign continues to be a topic of discussion. Replacing it is cost prohibited. One idea is to build a frame around it to make it look more appealing and inviting. Tony will look into what other churches may have done, come up with a cost, and present it to the trustees.
