The "Other"

Have you ever been the "Other," the outcast, the dreg, the one overlooked or uninvited? If you have, then you know the pain of so many. If you haven't, count yourself lucky. Being the one judged on things which you have little to no control over, poor decisions made out of choosing between the better of two bad choices or simply having made a mistake which one cannot get out from under, is probably one of the most hopeless lonely feelings there are in the world. Judgement has been passed by so many without having all the facts, getting to know the whole story, or even seeing the "other" as one of God's created blessings.

I have been extremely fortunate and honored in serving here at Roberts Congregational UCC where there are so many compassionate, loving people willing to help. I can honestly say that there has never been a time when I have reached out for one of these souls when the need or request has not been met in one way or another. It is truly a blessing I cherish and thank God for regularly. Especially in a time in society when so many are dividing into groups of "Us" and "Others." And it is not just meeting financial needs or people's needs for material things. This congregation has a way of welcoming whoever walks through the doors and creating a safe place for them to come and just be.

There is another piece to this which I want to invite you into though. It is the part of ministry which many of you never get to experience. People come to me. I meet with them and hear their stories. I sit with them in some pretty dark places in their lives. I get to know them as individuals and God's blessings through the process. Then I reach out to all of you, and you lovingly meet the needs. With great compassion and trust in what I tell you, you step up with money and things in order to change a specific immediate situation. It is what happens next which is the gift you miss

out on. It is the way in which meeting those needs actually changes lives, gives hope, and begins the opportunity for God to work in the lives of these people. Now, it isn't something which happens immediately. Quite often it takes years and may be something not seen at all if they do not return. Yet, when it does happen and you experience God's grace having worked in and through you. It is a feeling which enlivens the spirit and changes not only the other; it changes you. Knowing that God has done something through you is a feeling I cannot put adequately into words.

Many of you have seen the new slogan which the Church Board Team put together from the data they collect from all of you on who we are and who we want to be as a church family, and it is more fitting than you may know:

Come be ALIVE with us...

This isn't just a catch phrase. It is an identity statement. It is how we are viewed, and we view ourselves. And more than that it is true! I can tell you firsthand how many people have marveled at coming through our doors they have not felt judged or like they were "other." Instead, they talk about feeling like they were accepted, loved, invited, valued, and encouraged. Yet, most of you will have to take my word for that because they are not coming to you and saying it. Because I am the Pastor, they come to me. You also do not get to experience the gift of that moment when God has used the gifts you have provided in order to change lives because it is being managed through the ministry you are paying me to do. And I do so with all humility knowing that none of it would be possible without your kindness and generosity as a church family.

I am inviting you to come and take part though. There are many ministries happening within our walls in which you could have these exact same moments as you serve God. The Food Pantry, Feed My Starving Children, The Feel-Good Kits, Grace Place, Fellowship Dinners, RUCCUS, Confirmation, Rise, Bells, Greeting, Ushering, Coffee Fellowship, participating in service (reading, singing, collecting, being an acolyte, helping serve Communion, and a new ministry which is starting...Visiting). All of these are places where we can minister in various ways and become a part of the greater ministry of the church and in the process experience others and God in some other way. The bonds that are made, the friendships created, getting to know "others" at a deeper level, all have the opportunity of deepening your experience of God and also creating opportunities to be more ALIVE and part of the ministry of this church family.

I invite you to "Come Be Alive With Us" in new ways and help to bring God's message to more and more individuals. Let's live into this identity in more than just word...let's do it in our actions as well. Let's become active participants in the ministry of God here at Roberts UCC and not just Participant Observers. I know the love and faith all of you have. It is deep and full. Find that thing which you have a passion for and join in ministering with God through it. If it doesn't yet exist, then talk with me or another leader and let's make it happen. If it is something you are interested in, I assure you there will be at a minimum one other person who feels the same passion. "Come Be Alive With Us" and let us be ALIVE with you!

NEW VISITATION MINISTRY TEAM: FULFILLING THE CALL OF MATTHEW 25

We are excited to announce the launch of a new **Visitation Ministry Team** at Roberts UCC, inspired by the words of Jesus in

Matthew 25:34-40:

"I was sick and you visited me... Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me."

This new ministry team seeks to connect members of our church family through meaningful visits—bringing comfort, encouragement, and the love of Christ to those who are homebound or in need of personal connection.

Here's how it works:

- We are forming a Visitation Team made up of caring individuals who are willing to visit others on a regular basis. You don't need special training—just a willing heart and a little time to share.
- We are also creating a list of "visitees"—those in our congregation who would appreciate a visit, such as shut-ins, those recovering from illness, or others in need of encouragement.
- The Visitation Team will coordinate visits to ensure everyone on the list receives care, prayer, and fellowship. We will also keep track of visits to help us serve consistently and faithfully.

Are you looking for an easier way to donate to the church without having to write a check every week? Maybe with summer coming you won't be in town every weekend to bring your weekly contribution.


ELECTRONIC TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM YOUR BANK
