From the Pastor's Desk...

"I came that they may have life and have it abundantly."

—John 10:10

This Advent, we continue to journey with our theme: ****Come Be ALIVE With Us****—a reminder that in Christ we are:

****A – Accepted****
****L – Loved****
****I – Invited****
****V – Valued****
****E – Encouraged****

These five words shape the heart of our life together. As we enter this season of Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love, we prepare not only to celebrate the birth of Christ, but to welcome the fullness of life he brings. Jesus entered our world so that we might truly live—deeply, abundantly, and joyfully.

****First Sunday of Advent – Hope****

We begin with ***Acceptance*** and ***Invitation***. The birth of Jesus reminds us that God's love enters even the most unexpected circumstances. Christ—born in simplicity, surrounded by uncertainty—knows what it is to be overlooked and misunderstood. Yet Mary's courageous “Yes” opened the way for God's life-giving plan to unfold.

As we reflect on Hope, we ask: ****How will we answer God's invitation? **** What might God be preparing to bring into the world through our own faithful “Yes”?

****Second Sunday of Advent – Peace****

This week, we reflect on ***Value***—the deep truth that each of us is cherished by God. No one is lost in the crowd. In my own woodworking, I have begun to see beauty in the grain, knots, and markings that make each piece unique. God sees us the same way—beautiful not in spite of our flaws, but in the way our gifts and imperfections are woven into who we are.

As we consider Peace, we ask: ****How might we look at others with the same tenderness God shows us?**** How can we celebrate the whole person rather than sorting one another by strengths and weaknesses?

Third Sunday of Advent – Joy

This Sunday invites us to reflect on *Encouragement*. None of us moves through life without moments of doubt or feelings of insignificance. Jesus continually lifted up those who felt unseen or unworthy, and we are called to do the same.

Even Mary and Joseph—facing fear, uncertainty, and a newborn child—found Joy in the presence of Christ. They also found Joy in community, trusting those around them as they raised their son.

So we ask: **How can we become a community of encouragement?** How can we help newcomers—and one another—feel truly welcomed, supported, and uplifted?

Fourth Sunday of Advent – Love

In Christ's birth we encounter Love made tangible. Emmanuel—God with us—arrives not as an idea, but as a living, breathing child. The promises of old become flesh before our eyes.

And now, we are bearers of that Love. Though Jesus is no longer present in the flesh, the Love he brought continues through us. When we support one another, when we carry each other's burdens, when we offer kindness in Christ's name, **Emmanuel is still with us**.

So come—walk with us this Advent. Bring your gifts, your story, your beautifully unique self. Say “Yes” to the journey. Come *Be ALIVE* with us as we discover again the Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love made real in Jesus Christ.


